
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 11602, GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM AND TO ENACT A NEW SECTION 11602,
CHAPTER 7, TITLE XII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11602, Government Code of Guam, is hereby
3 repealed and a new Section 11602 is hereby added to Chapter 7, Title XII,
4 Government Code of Guam, as follows:

5 "Section 11602. Tuition, Fees and Charges.

6 Tuition to the College of Guam shall be free to all permanent
7 residents of Guam and all United States citizens. In the
8 discretion of the Board, and subject to the approval of the
9 Governor, tuition may be required of other persons. Tuition,
10 fees and other charges shall be fixed by the Board with the
11 approval of the Governor."

12 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
