AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE POWER
SINKING FUND AND AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE THEREOF
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF POWER GENERATING FACILITIES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$3,000,000
3 from the Power Sinking Fund as a continuing project within the General Fund
4 for the purpose of making payments to the United States of America for the
5 Government of Guam share of the cost of a power generating plant in accord
6 with the Memorandum of Understanding entered into by the Government of Guam
7 and Commander Naval Forces Marianas on June 21, 1960, and the Governor is
8 hereby authorized to make such payments subject to the following conditions:

9 (a) That the cost to the United States for its
10 share of the power generating facility is fully appropriated
11 and funded to the Department of the Navy for this project;

12 (b) That each payment to the United States shall be
13 authorized by the Governor upon billing by the Commander
14 Naval Forces Marianas, at the rate of 36% of each payment
15 or partial payment due under each contract, in which the
16 Government of Guam is participating, for equipment, con-
17 struction, and engineering and design, entered into by
18 the Navy for this project, or such other arrangement as
19 may be made between the Governor and the Commander Naval
20 Forces Marianas, but in no event shall each such payment
21 be made to the United States sooner than any payment or
22 partial payment is due from the Department of the Navy
23 under each such contract;

24 (c) That in no event shall the sum total of all
25 payments made under (b) hereof exceed \$3,000,000.

26 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
