

Introduced by J. T. Sablan

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER 1, TITLE XI,
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, AND TO ENACT
A NEW CHAPTER 1, TITLE XI, GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM, RELATING TO THE EMPLOY-
MENT OF ALIENS ON GOVERNMENT CONTRACTS
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Chapter 1, Title XI, Government Code of Guam,
3 is hereby repealed.

4 Section 2. A new Chapter 1, Title XI, Government Code of Guam,
5 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 "CHAPTER 1

7 Contracts for Public Works

8 Section 10001. Public Works: Employment of Aliens. No
9 contractor or subcontractor engaged in the construction of
10 public works for the Government of Guam shall knowingly employ,
11 or permit to be employed, any alien in such construction
12 except in cases of extraordinary emergency which endanger
13 life or property, or upon certification by the Employment
14 Service of the Department of Labor and Personnel that United
15 States citizens are not available in Guam in the craft or
16 skill of employee required.

17 Section 10001.1. Report of Emergency. Within thirty
18 days after any alien is permitted to work in the construction
19 of public works due to an extraordinary emergency, the
20 contractor shall file with the contracting officer of the
21 government a verified report setting forth the nature of the
22 emergency, the name of the alien, and each date he was permitted
23 to work.

24 Section 10001.2. Record of Citizenship of Workman. Every
25 contractor and subcontractor shall keep an accurate record

1 showing the name and citizenship of each workman employed by
2 him in the construction of public works for the Government of
3 Guam. The record shall be kept open at all reasonable hours
4 for inspection by the contracting officer of the Government
5 of Guam.

6 Section 10001.3. Penalty for Employing Alien. Any
7 contractor engaged in the construction of public works for
8 the Government of Guam shall forfeit as a penalty to the
9 Government of Guam, ten dollars for each alien knowingly
10 employed in such construction, by either such contractor
11 or a subcontractor, for each calendar day, or portion
12 thereof, during which each such alien is permitted or re-
13 quired to labor in violation of this Chapter. All contracts
14 awarded for the construction of public works shall contain
15 provision for such forfeiture.

16 Section 10001.4. Minimum Wage. All contracts executed
17 by the Government of Guam for the construction of public
18 works shall provide that persons employed thereon shall be
19 paid not less than the minimum wage applicable to the
20 corresponding skill or craft in the service of the Government
21 of Guam.

22 Section 10001.5. Definitions. For purposes of this
23 Chapter the term 'construction of public works' shall mean
24 and include work performed pursuant to contract for the
25 erection, maintenance, rehabilitation, repair or demolition
26 of any public building, roadway, or other public facility.
27 The term 'alien' shall not include permanent residents of the
28 United States or immigrant aliens eligible for United States
29 citizenship."

30 Section 3. This Act shall not apply with respect to contracts

1 executed, or for which requests for bids are published, prior to the
2 effective date hereof.

3 **Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure.**
