AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 16105 OF TITLE XVII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, THE BUSINESS LICENSE LAW, BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION 16105.01 WITH REFERENCE TO LICENSES, FOR THE SELLING OF PROPERTY AT RETAIL THROUGH COIN VENDING MACHINES, BY AMENDING SECTION 16016, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 16105 of Title XVII, Government Code of Guam,  
3 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsection:

4 ".01. Except that in the case of a licensee engaged in the  
5 selling of such property through coin vending machines, the annual  
6 fee is Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each coin machine so operated,  
7 notwithstanding Section 16019 of the Government Code of Guam."

8 Section 2. Section 16016 of Title XVII, Government Code of Guam,  
9 is hereby amended to read as follows:

10 "Section 16016. Licenses Not Transferable. Every license  
11 issued under this Title shall be deemed to be personal and shall  
12 be issued to the person or persons making application therefor,  
13 and may not in any circumstances be transferred to any other  
14 person except upon the forfeiture of a tenancy or upon a fore-  
15 closure of a mortgage where the original contract provides that  
16 the license is a security for the obligation in which event the  
17 Board shall be promptly notified of any such forfeiture. Any  
18 license conditioned upon the fulfillment of any qualifications  
19 or prerequisites pertaining to the premises wherein the licensee  
20 conducts his business, trade or profession may not be transferred  
21 to another location without written application to, and written  
22 approval by the Director of Finance."

23 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
