AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 16105 OF TITLE XVII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, THE BUSINESS LICENSE LAW, BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION 16105.01 WITH REFERENCE TO LICENSES, FOR THE SELLING OF PROPERTY AT RETAIL THROUGH COIN VENDING MACHINES, BY AMENDING SECTION 16016, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

 Section 1. Section 16105 of Title XVII, Government Code of Guam,

 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsection:

".01. Except that in the case of a licensee engaged in the selling of such property through coin vending machines, the annual fee is Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each coin machine so operated, notwithstanding Section 16019 of the Government Code of Guam." Section 2. Section 16016 of Title XVII, Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 16016. Licenses Not Transferable. Every license issued under this Title shall be deemed to be personal and shall be issued to the person or persons making application therefor, and may not in any circumstances be transferred to any other person except upon the forfeiture of a tenancy or upon a foreclosure of a mortgage where the original contract provides that the license is a security for the obligation in which event the Board shall be promptly notified of any such forfeiture. Any license conditioned upon the fulfillment of any qualifications or prerequisites pertaining to the premises wherein the licensee conducts his business, trade or profession may not be transferred to another location without written application to, and written approval by the Director of Finance."
