AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE ACQUISITION BY THE GOVERNMENT OF PUBLIC ROAD RIGHT OF WAYS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the government of Guam the sum of One Hundred Six Thousand Thirty-Three Dollars (\$106,033.00) for the acquisition in fee simple by the government of Guam of parcels of land for the purpose of acquiring public road right of ways.

Section 2. The funds appropriated in this Act shall be administered by the Director of Land Management or his designee and shall be accounted for by the Department of Finance in an allotment account separate and distinct from any now used to account for funds previously appropriated.

Section 3. The appropriation made in this Act shall remain in full force and effect until such time as the Director of Land Management or his designee shall request the closing out of the appropriation or until such time as future legislation may dictate.
