AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATION FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
2	Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law the
3	unexpended balance of monies previously appropriated by (1) Section 6(1)
4	of Public Law 7, Third Guam Legislature and Section 1 of Public Law 73,
5	Fourth Guam Legislature, both carried as allotment account 9106, (2)
6	Section 1 of Public Law 94, Third Guam Legislature, carried as allotment
7	account 9718, (3) Section 1 of Public Law 84, Fourth Guam Legislature,
8	carried as allotment account 923, and (4) Section 3 of Public Law 5-100,
9	carried as allotment account 1028, are hereby reverted to the Unappropriated
10	Surplus of the General Fund and shall be available for purposes of
11	appropriations within this Act.
12	Section 2. There are hereby appropriated the following amounts
13	for the purposes indicated from any available funds in the Unappropriated
14	Surplus of the General Fund:
15	(a) To continue and complete the program provided
16	for in Section 1, Public Law 94, Third Guam
17	Legislature, and for a management survey of
18	the Department of Land Management, and imple-
19	mentation of survey recommendations \$ 39,000
20	(b) To supplement the funds previously appro-
21	priated in Public Law 5-95 for reclamation
22	of government owned land in the Agana Swamp
23	and land fill on the Paseo de Susana 75,000
24	(c) For the maintenance of permanent housing for
25	government of Guam employees 50,000
26	(d) To provide funds for the payment of land
27	rentals owed by the government 12,150

(e) For the School Book Fund 15,000

(f) For permanent school construction 48,000 The appropriations made in this section shall be available for all expenses incidental to the purposes for which made, and shall remain available until such purposes are accomplished.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
