AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE OFFICE OF
THE GOVERNOR OF GUAM TO PROVIDE GRANTS FOR
THE TRAINING OF RETARDED CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Governor of Guam from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the government of Guam the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) for the purpose of providing facilities for the training of retarded children. The Governor of Guam is authorized to provide such facilities through grants to private nonprofit organizations specifically organized and operated for such purposes.

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
