




AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR NECESSARY  
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 ~~Section 1. There are hereby appropriated from any available~~  
3 ~~funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, the following~~  
4 ~~sums for the purposes set forth herein:~~

- 5 (a) ~~Construction of a water line in Nimitz,~~  
6 ~~San Isidro, Agat~~ \$ ~~20,000~~
- 7 (b) ~~Extension of water line from Inarajan~~  
8 ~~Village to Lada area~~ 25,000
- 9 (c) ~~For extension of water facilities to the~~  
10 ~~Pulantat, As Namu and As Manano area in Yona~~ 49,000

11 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
12 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One  
13 Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$151,500.00) for the  
14 purpose of acquiring, improving and equipping recreation areas, including  
15 playgrounds and civic centers, as needed or desirable throughout Guam.  
16 The monies appropriated in this section shall be accounted for separately  
17 from the monies previously appropriated in Public Law 5-20. The intent  
18 of this appropriation is to provide funds for, but is not limited to,  
19 the following projects:

- 20 (a) Santa Rita - \$4,500 to provide fill to prevent erosion  
21 of the recreation area, and \$10,000 for a basketball  
22 court with lights;
- 23 (b) Dededo - \$12,000 to improve the recreational facilities;
- 24 (c) Talofofo - \$10,000 to provide a basketball court  
25 with lights;
- 26 (d) Yigo - \$10,000 to provide a basketball court with  
27 lights;

- 1 (e) Agana Heights - \$3,000 for lighting, and \$9,000 for a
- 2 baseball field;
- 3 (f) Ordot-Chalan Pago - \$10,000 for acquisition of a
- 4 recreation site;
- 5 (g) Tamuning - \$10,000 for a basketball court with lights;
- 6 (h) Merizo - \$10,000 for a basketball court with lights;
- 7 (i) Mangilao - \$3,000 for lighting;
- 8 (j) Mongmong-Toto - \$3,000 for lighting;
- 9 (k) Piti - \$3,000 for lighting, and \$1,000 for grading
- 10 recreational area;
- 11 (l) Adelup School area - \$5,000 for top soil, grading, and
- 12 baseball field backstop;
- 13 (m) Yona - \$15,000 to complete the baseball field and
- 14 provide a basketball court; and
- 15 (n) Paseo de Susana - \$18,000 for completion of lighting
- 16 facilities at the existing baseball field, and \$15,000
- 17 for the preparation of plans for the construction of
- 18 a public auditorium and sports arena.

19 Section 3. There ~~are~~ hereby appropriated from any available funds  
 20 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the following amounts  
 21 for the purposes set forth herein:

- 22 (a) For preparation of plans and specifications
- 23 for the psychiatric wing at the Guam Memorial
- 24 Hospital \$ 10,000
- 25 (b) For exterior painting of the tuberculosis
- 26 wing of the Guam Memorial Hospital 5,000
- 27 (c) For the construction of permanent public
- 28 health centers with matching funds from
- 29 the Federal Government under the Hill-
- 30 Burton Act 20,000
- 31 (d) For construction of additions to Public

2	the Commissioners of Talofofo, Inarajan,

15 Section 4. There are hereby appropriated from any available  
16 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the following

24 Section 5. The appropriations made by this Act shall be

25 effective immediately, and shall be available for all expenses incident

26 to the purposes for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall

27 continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended

28 for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project

29 is completed. Appropriations made for capital improvements under this

30 and prior Acts may be used for the employment of technical, professional

31 and other skilled personnel for use on capital improvement projects for

1        which such appropriations were made; such personnel may be employed on  
2        such terms as authorized by the Governor and may include the furnishing  
3        of travel, transportation and housing; the provisions of Title V,  
4        Government Code of Guam, shall not apply to such personnel, except as  
5        may be authorized by the Governor.

6                    Section 6. This Act is an urgency measure.

The within and foregoing Bill No. 389 is APPROVED by me, EXCEPT AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 1 in its entirety including:

The item of \$20,000 appropriated in subsection (a);  
The item of \$25,000 appropriated in subsection (b); and  
The item of \$49,000 appropriated in subsection (c);

2. The item of \$5,000 appropriated in Section 4 (b); and  
3. The item of \$8,500 appropriated in Section 4 (j);

to which said items, and each of them, I object, and I have stricken the same,  
and each of them, from the original Bill in its entirety.
