AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 4006.2 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE FOR A UNIFORM ANNUAL LEAVE SYSTEM FOR GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 4006.2.of Chapter 1, Title V, of the Government Code of Guam is hereby added to read as follows:

"Section 4006.2. Annual leave. (a) Annual leave periods shall be granted employees occupying permanent positions, except personnel of the Department of Education who are employed on a school-year basis, in accordance with the following schedule:

- (1) One-half day (4 hours) for each full biweekly pay period in the case of employees with less than three years of service.
- (2) Three-fourths day (6 hours) for each biweekly pay period (except that the accrual for the last full biweekly pay period in the year shall be one and one-fourth day (10 hours)) in the case of employees with three but less than fifteen years of service.
- (3) One day for each full biweekly pay period in the case of employees with fifteen years or more service.
- (b) The term 'years of service' shall be deemed to include service with the Naval Government of Guam or with other Federal instrumentalities or agencies within Guam prior to August 1, 1950.
- (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to preclude provision, by appropriate Personnel Rules and Regulations, for annual leave for employees occupying permanent positions excepted from application of this section, and such other matters as are essential or incidental to the administration of the leave system, including but not limited to accumulation and carry-over of leave

to succeeding fiscal years."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
