AH ACT TO ADD BECTIONS 11112 AND 11113 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN RELATING TO THE DISPLAY OF AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE AMERICAN PLAG.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PROPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 11112 to hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 11112. WHITED STATES PLAGE DUTY OF BOARD TO PROVIDE. The Board shall provide for each public school under its control, including the College of Guam, a suitable flag of the United States, which shall be hoisted above each school during all day sessions, weather permitting. The Board shall also provide smaller and suitable United States flags to be displayed in each schoolroom at all times during the school sessions."

Section 2. Section 11113 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 11113. SAME: PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO. It shall be the duty of the Board to adopt and place into effect for the public schools of Quam rules and regulations requiring students at a suitable time during school sessions to pledge allegiance to the United States flag and to the matter for which it stands. Such pledge shall be in the following words:

'I pleage allegiance to the flag of the United States of America, and to the Republic for which it stands; one nation under God, indivisible with liberty and justice for all'."

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
