



**AN ACT TO ADD SECTIONS 11112 AND 11113 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO THE DISPLAY
OF AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE AMERICAN FLAG.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Section 11112 is hereby added to the Government Code**
3 **of Guam to read as follows:**

4 **"Section 11112. UNITED STATES FLAG: DUTY OF BOARD TO**
5 **PROVIDE. The Board shall provide for each public school**
6 **under its control, including the College of Guam, a suitable**
7 **flag of the United States, which shall be hoisted above each**
8 **school during all day sessions, weather permitting. The**
9 **Board shall also provide smaller and suitable United States**
10 **flags to be displayed in each schoolroom at all times during**
11 **the school sessions."**

12 **Section 2. Section 11113 is hereby added to the Government Code**
13 **of Guam to read as follows:**

14 **"Section 11113. SAME: PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO. It shall**
15 **be the duty of the Board to adopt and place into effect for**
16 **the public schools of Guam rules and regulations requiring**
17 **students at a suitable time during school sessions to pledge**
18 **allegiance to the United States flag and to the nation for**
19 **which it stands. Such pledge shall be in the following words:**

20 **'I pledge allegiance to the flag of the United States**
21 **of America, and to the Republic for which it stands; one**
22 **nation under God, indivisible with liberty and justice for**
23 **all'."**

24 **Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.**
