Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the Seneral Fund the sum of \$70,000 to supplement the appropriation made by Section 3, Item (h) of Fublic Law 5-145 for the rehabilitation of housing units in Harmon Village.

Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$2,000 to reimburse the Liberation Day Fund for the cost of constructing an Inauguration Day Float representing the territory in the Presidential Inauguration Farade at Washington, D. C.

Section 6. Section 3 of Public Law 5-30 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the government of Quam not heretofore appropriated, the sum of Six Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$623,800) for construction of and for the purchase of collateral equipment for an elementary school and a junior high school in Barrigada and an additional sixteen (16) classrooms at the present Andersen Elementary School, and for additions and replacements to elementary schools at Durajan, Merizo, Talofofo, and Chalan Pago-Ordot."

Section 7. The appropriations made by this Act shall be effective immediately, and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed. Appropriations made for capital improvements under this and prior Acts may be used for the employment of technical, professional and other skilled personnel for use on capital improvement projects for which such appropriations were made; such personnel may be employed on such terms as authorized by the Governor and may include
