

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR NECESSARY  
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There are hereby appropriated from any available funds  
in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, the following sums for  
the purposes set forth herein:

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds  
in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$75,000 for the

3 *Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds*  
4 *in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$70,000 to supple-*  
5 *ment the appropriation made by Section 3, Item (h) of Public Law 5-145 for the*  
6 *rehabilitation of housing units in Harmon Village.*

7 *Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in*  
8 *the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$2,000 to reimburse*  
9 *the Liberation Day Fund for the cost of constructing an Inauguration Day Float*  
10 *representing the territory in the Presidential Inauguration Parade at*  
11 *Washington, D. C.*

12 *Section 6. Section 3 of Public Law 5-30 is hereby amended to*  
13 *read as follows:*

14 *"Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available*  
15 *funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the*  
16 *government of Guam not heretofore appropriated, the sum of*  
17 *Six Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars*  
18 *(\$623,800) for construction of and for the purchase of*  
19 *collateral equipment for an elementary school and a junior*  
20 *high school in Barrigada and an additional sixteen (16)*  
21 *classrooms at the present Andersen Elementary School, and*  
22 *for additions and replacements to elementary schools at*  
23 *Darajan, Merizo, Talefofo, and Chalan Pago-Ordot."*

24 *Section 7. The appropriations made by this Act shall be effective*  
25 *immediately, and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes*  
26 *for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full force*  
27 *and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which the*  
28 *appropriation is made or until the project is completed. Appropriations made*  
29 *for capital improvements under this and prior Acts may be used for the employ-*  
30 *ment of technical, professional and other skilled personnel for use on capital*  
31 *improvement projects for which such appropriations were made; such personnel*  
32 *may be employed on such terms as authorized by the Governor and may include*

Section 4. There is hereby established a new class of personnel  
known as "personnel."

Personnel of Government shall not be deemed to be included in the  
the furnishing of travel, transportation and housing; the provisions of  
Title V, Government Code of Guam, shall not apply to such personnel, except  
as may be authorized by the Governor.

Section 8. This Act is an urgency measure.
