AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (m) OF SECTION 37014 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GURN RELATIVE TO TOTAL COMPENSATION PAYABLE UNDER THE "WORKHEN'S COM-PENSATION LAN".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN:

Section 1. Subsection (m) of Section 37014 of the Government

Code of Guan is hereby amended to read as follows:

*(m) The total compensation payable under this

title for injuries not resulting in death shall in no

event exceed the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).

In cases of disability compensable under paragraph (21)

of subsection (c) of Section 37008 the total compensa
tion for such disability, and for any temporary total

disability or temporary partial disability sustained in

addition thereto, shall not exceed in the apprepare the

sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000)."

Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall be applicable only to injuries or deaths occurring on or after the effective date hereof.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
