Introduced by J. L. Anderson

AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (a) OF SECTION 37014
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO TOTAL
COMPENSATION PAYABLE UNDER THE "WORKMEN'S COM-
PENSATION LAW".

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subsection (a) of Section 37014 of the Government
3 Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 (a) The total compensation payable under this
5 title for injuries not resulting in death shall in no
6 event exceed the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).
7 In cases of disability compensable under paragraph (21)
8 of subsection (c) of Section 37008 the total compensa-
9 tion for such disability, and for any temporary total
10 disability or temporary partial disability sustained in
11 addition thereto, shall not exceed in the aggregate the
12 sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000)."

13 Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall be applicable only
14 to injuries or deaths occurring on or after the effective date hereof.

15 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
