


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION
OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT FOR
THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1962.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There are hereby appropriated from any available funds
3 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, the following sums for
4 operation of the Executive Branch of the government of Guam for the fiscal
5 year ending June 30, 1962:

21 Section 2. Any grant received from the United States Government as
22 general fund revenue, is specifically authorized for the purpose, or purposes,
23 for which such grant is made.

24 Section 3. The Governor of Guam may transfer not to exceed ten per
25 cent (10%) of any appropriation of Section 1, above, to any other item or

1 items of the appropriation of Section 1, but no item of appropriation shall
2 be increased more than ten percentum as a result of such transfer; provided,
3 that quarterly a statement of any such transfer shall be transmitted to the
