AN ACT TO ADD CHAPTER IV TO TITLE II OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM PERTAINING TO THE AUDIT
OR REVIEW OF ALL GOVERNMENT OF GUAM ACCOUNTS AND
FINANCIAL TRANSACTION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Chapter IV is hereby added to Title II of the
3 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "CHAPTER IV

5 Audit of Governmental Accounts and Financial Transaction

6 Section 1300. Legislative Audit

7 Section 1301. Same: Submission of Firms
8 to Legislature

9 Section 1300. Legislative Audit. Notwithstanding any
10 other provision of law the Legislature shall, annually,
11 audit or cause an audit to be made of all government of
12 Guam accounts and financial transactions, by an inde-
13 pendent audit firm or organization, which audit shall be
14 under the direction and supervision of the Legislature.

15 Section 1301. Same: Submission of Firms to
16 Legislature. In conjunction with such audit, the Governor
17 shall submit to the Legislature the names of several audit
18 firms or organizations, and the Legislature shall only enter
19 into a contract with any one of the several firms so submitted."

20 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
