AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 8209.1 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN PERTAINING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN: Section 1. A new Section 0209.1 is hereby added to Chapter 3. Title IX. Government Code of Guan, to read as follows:

> "Section 8209.1. Same: Exclusion. The term "fireworks" in Section 8209 shall not be construed to include caps as used in toy pistols, and party favors containing comparable small amounts of explosives. The Director of Public Safety shall determine what items come within this section."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
