AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ERECTION OF A SUITABLE MARKER ON SKINNER PLAZA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the government of Guam, the sum of \$1,500.00 to provide for the acquisition and erection of a suitable permanent marker commemorating the dedication of Skinner Plaza. The Governor of Guam, Speaker of the Legislature, and Chief Judge of the Island Court, shall constitute a commission to approve the material, design, inscription and location.

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
