
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ERECTION OF A  
SUITABLE MARKER ON SKINNER PLAZA.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds  
3 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the government of Guam,  
4 the sum of \$1,500.00 to provide for the acquisition and erection of a suit-  
5 able permanent marker commemorating the dedication of Skinner Plaza. The  
6 Governor of Guam, Speaker of the Legislature, and Chief Judge of the  
7 Island Court, shall constitute a commission to approve the material, design,  
8 inscription and location.

9 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
