AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 115.1 TO CHAPTER IV. TITLE VII. PART I. OF THE PENAL CODE OF GUAH RELATING TO FALSE STATEMENTS OR ENTRIES GENERALLY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN:
Section 1. A new Section 115.1 is hereby added to Chapter IV.
Title VII. Part I, of the Penal Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 115.1. Whoever, in any matter within the jurisdiction of any department, board, commission, or agency of the government of Guam, knowingly and wilfully falsifies, conceals or covers up by any trick, scheme, or device a material fact, or makes any false, fictitious or fraudulent statements or representations, or makes or uses any false writing or document knowing the same to contain any false, fictitious or fraudulent statement or entry, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor."
