AN ACT TO ADD SUBSECTION (e) TO SECTION 23104 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE RED SIGNAL LIGHTS FOR SCHOOL BUSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subsection (e) is hereby added to Section 23104 of
the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"(e) Every school bus upon the public highway shall, in addition to any other equipment and distinctive markings required by this Act, be equipped with signal lamps mounted as high and as widely spaced laterally as practicable, which shall be capable of displaying to the front two alternately flashing red lights located at the same level and to the rear two alternately flashing red lights located at the same level, and which red signal lights shall emit a red light plainly visible under normal atmospheric conditions for a distance of five hundred (500) feet from the rear or the front of such vehicle."
