AN ACT TO ADD SUBSECTION (e) TO SECTION
23104 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO
REQUIRE RED SIGNAL LIGHTS FOR SCHOOL
BUSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subsection (e) is hereby added to Section 23104 of
3 the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "(e) Every school bus upon the public highway
5 shall, in addition to any other equipment and distinctive
6 markings required by this Act, be equipped with signal
7 lamps mounted as high and as widely spaced laterally as
8 practicable, which shall be capable of displaying to the
9 front two alternately flashing red lights located at the
10 same level and to the rear two alternately flashing red
11 lights located at the same level, and which red signal
12 lights shall emit a red light plainly visible under
13 normal atmospheric conditions for a distance of five
14 hundred (500) feet from the rear or the front of such
15 vehicle."
