AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE MAINTENANCE  
OF THE GUAM CONGRESS BUILDING FOR THE FISCAL  
YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1962.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds  
3 of the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the government of Guam  
4 the sum of ~~Thirty-Eight Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Two Dollars (\$38,342.00)~~  
5 Thirty Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars (\$30,662.00)  
6 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962, for the maintenance of the Guam  
7 Congress Building, including, but not limited, to wages and salaries for  
8 janitors, janitorial and such other necessary supplies and equipment, and  
9 utilities excluding telephone. The appropriation herein made shall be  
10 administered in accordance with appropriate Standing Rules of the Guam  
11 Legislature.

12 Section 2. The appropriation made by Public Law 6-14 for the  
13 operational expenses of the Legislative Branch of the government for the  
14 calendar year ending December 31, 1961, is hereby reduced by Six Thousand  
15 Nine Hundred Dollars (\$6,900.00).

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
