Substitute bill by Committee on Finance and Taxation

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE GUAN CONGRESS BUILDING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1962.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds of the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the government of Guam Thirty Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars (\$30,662.00) the sum of Thirty-Fight Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Two Dollars (\$30,662.00) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962, for the maintenance of the Guam Congress Building, including, but not limited, to wages and salaries for janitors, janitorial and such other necessary supplies and equipment, and utilities excluding telephone. The appropriation herein made shall be administered in accordance with appropriate Standing Rules of the Guam Legislature.

Section 2. The appropriation made by Public Law 6-14 for the operational expenses of the Legislative Branch of the government for the calendar year ending December 31, 1961, is hereby reduced by Six Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$6,900.00).

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
