Substitute bill by Committee on Finance and Taxation

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATION FOR THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF THE TERRITORY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000,00) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962, to be expended by the Governor of Guam for the economic development of the territory, including fishing and agriculture but not limited thereto, in such manner and for such projects and programs as he may determine.

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
