

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATION FOR THE ECONOMIC  
DEVELOPMENT OF THE TERRITORY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds  
3 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred  
4 Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962, to  
5 be expended by the Governor of Guam for the economic development of the  
6 territory, including fishing and agriculture but not limited thereto, in  
7 such manner and for such projects and programs as he may determine.

8 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
