AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR
OPERATION OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE
GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
ENDING JUNE 30, 1961, AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds
3 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Four Thousand
4 Five Hundred Dollars and No/Cents (\$4,500.00) to supplement the funds pre-
5 viously appropriated in Item 6, of Section 1, Public Law 98, Fourth Guam
6 Legislature, as amended by Public Law 5-26, for moving expenses in connec-
7 tion with the occupancy of the new Administration Building.

8 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds
9 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Sixty-Eight
10 Thousand Dollars and No/Cents (\$68,000.00) to supplement the funds previously
11 appropriated in Section 1 of Public Law 5-101 for the Executive Branch's
12 contribution to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund for the fiscal year
13 ending June 30, 1961.

14 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds
15 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Thousand
16 Seven Hundred Dollars and No/Cents (\$1,700.00) to supplement the appropria-
17 tion made by Public Law 5-105 for an audit of the accounts and financial
18 transactions of the government of Guam for the fiscal year ended June 30,
19 1960.

20 Section 4. The appropriations made in this Act shall be effective
21 as of June 30, 1961 and shall continue in full force and effect and shall be
22 available until expended for the project for which the appropriation is made
23 or until the project is completed.

24 Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
