Substitute bill by Committee on Finance and Taxation

AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR OPERATION OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1961, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and No/Cents (\$4,500.00) to supplement the funds previously appropriated in Item 6.of Section 1. Public Law 98. Fourth Guam Legislature, as amended by Public Law 5-26, for moving expenses in connection with the occupancy of the new Administration Building.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Sixty-Eight Thousand Dollars and No/Cents (\$68,000,00) to supplement the funds previously appropriated in Section 1 of Public Law 5-101 for the Executive Branch's contribution to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars and No/Cents (\$1,700.00) to supplement the appropriation made by Public Law 5-105 for an audit of the accounts and financial transactions of the government of Guam for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1960.

Section 4. The appropriations made in this Act shall be effective as of June 30, 1961 and shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed.

Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
