AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 11600, 11601, 11602,  
AND 11603, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, TO PROVIDE  
FOR FOUR-YEAR COURSES AT THE COLLEGE OF GUAM,  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11600, Chapter 10, Title XII, Government  
3 Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read:

4 "Section 11630. Designation of College; Four-Year Course;  
5 Degrees. The college founded and established by the Government  
6 of Guam heretofore designated as the Territorial College of  
7 Guam shall be known and designated as the College of Guam,  
8 hereinafter referred to as the College. The College is  
9 authorized to establish and offer courses of study up to and  
10 including four-year courses, upon establishing of the necessary  
11 standards and curricula, and to confer upon students who com-  
12 plete prescribed courses of study appropriate baccalaureate  
13 degrees."

14 Section 2. Section 11601, Chapter 10, Title XII, Government  
15 Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read:

16 "Section 11831. Administration. The Director of Education  
17 shall be the President of the College of Guam ex officio. The  
18 administration of the College shall be in accordance with  
19 Section 11101 of the Government Code of Guam."

20 Section 3. Section 11602, Chapter 10, Title XII, Government  
21 Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read:

22 "Section 11832. Tuition, Fees and Charges. Tuition to  
23 the College shall be free to all permanent residents of Guam



1 and all United States citizens. In the discretion of the  
2 Board, and subject to the approval of the Governor by  
3 Executive Order, tuition may be required of other persons.  
4 Fees and other charges except tuition shall be fixed by the  
5 Board."

6 Section 4. Section 11603, Chapter 10, Title XII, Government  
7 Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read:

8 "Section 11633. Rules and Regulations as to Standards.  
9 The Board of Education in addition to exercising the powers  
10 enumerated in Section 11101 of the Government Code of Guam  
11 shall, pursuant to Section 11100, Government Code of Guam,  
12 adopt rules and regulations for the government of the College  
13 including the following:

- 14 (a) standards for admission and graduation,  
15 (b) establishment of courses of study,  
16 (c) creation of degrees and requirements for the  
17 conferring thereof, and  
18 (d) establishment of academic and physical standards  
19 for the achievement and maintenance of accredited  
20 status by the College."

21 Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
