AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There are hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the following sums for the purposes set forth herein:

(a)	For the continuation of the highways

(c)	For the continuation of the Pasco de

(d)	For construction of additional fire

(e)	For necessary improvements of the	
	facilities of the Detention Home:	5,500

Section 2. The sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the Workmen's Compensation Fund established by Section 37042 of the Government Code of Guam.

section 3. The sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000) is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to supplement funds previously appropriated by Public Law 5-99. Section 1. Item (i) for village public works purposes.

- Section 4. The sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) is hereby reappropriated from the unexpended and unencumbered balance of monies

previously appropriated by Section 1 of Public Law 95, Fifth Guam Legislature, and by Section 2(b) of Public Law 137, Fifth Guam Legislature, for the construction of sanitary facilities at the Pasco de Susana.

Section 5. The appropriations made by this Act shall be effective July 1, 1961, and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed.

Appropriations made for capital improvements under this and prior Acts may be used for the employment of technical, professional and other skilled personnel for use on capital improvement projects for which such appropriations were made; such personnel may be employed on such terms as authorized by the Governor and may include the furnishing of travel, transportation and housing; the provisions of Title V. Government Code of Guam, shall not apply to such personnel, except as may be authorized by the Governor.
