AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CERTAIN
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There are hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the following sums
4 for the purposes set forth herein:

- 5 (a) For the continuation of the highways
6 and pavement program: \$200,000
- 7 (b) For the continuation of the Parks
8 development program: 15,000
- 9 (c) For the continuation of the Paseo de
10 Susana development program: 18,000
- 11 (d) For construction of additional fire
12 fighting facilities and purchase of
13 necessary equipment: 45,546
- 14 (e) For necessary improvements of the
15 facilities of the Detention Home: 5,500

16 Section 2. The sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) is hereby
17 appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the
18 General Fund for the Workmen's Compensation Fund established by Section
19 37042 of the Government Code of Guam.

20 Section 3. The sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000) is hereby
21 appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the
22 General Fund to supplement funds previously appropriated by Public Law
23 5-99, Section 1, Item (i) for village public works purposes.

24 ~~Section 4. The sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) is hereby~~
25 ~~reappropriated from the unexpended and unencumbered balance of monies~~

4 Section 5. The appropriations made by this Act shall be effective
5 July 1, 1961, and shall be available for all expenses incident to the pur-
6 poses for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in
7 full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project
8 for which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed.
9 Appropriations made for capital improvements under this and prior Acts may
10 be used for the employment of technical, professional and other skilled
11 personnel for use on capital improvement projects for which such appropri-
12 tions were made; such personnel may be employed on such terms as authorized
13 by the Governor and may include the furnishing of travel, transportation
14 and housing; the provisions of Title V, Government Code of Guam, shall not
15 apply to such personnel, except as may be authorized by the Governor.
