AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE OFFICE
OF THE GOVERNOR OF GUAM TO PROVIDE GRANTS
FOR THE TRAINING OF RETARDED CHILDREN.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
3 Governor of Guam from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of
4 the General Fund the sum of Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000.00) to continue
5 the purpose of providing facilities for the training of retarded children
6 for which funds were appropriated in Public Law 5-140.

7 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
