Substitute bill by Committee on Finance and Taxation

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR OF GUAN TO PROVIDE GRANTS FOR THE TRAINING OF RETARDED CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Governor of Guam from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000.00) to continue the purpose of providing facilities for the training of retarded children for which funds were appropriated in Public Law 5-140.

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
