AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 2981 TO THE CIVIL CODE OF GUAR PERTAINING TO THE UNLAWFUL REMOVAL OF MOTOR VEHICLES SUBJECT TO A CONDITIONAL SALE CONTRACT OR MORTGAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN:

Section 1. Section 2981 is hereby added to the Civil Code of Guan
to read as follows:

"Section 2981. Unlawful removal of motor vehicles subject to a conditional sale contract or mortgage. It shall be unlawful for any person to remove, attempt to remove, cause to be removed or assist in so doing any motor vehicle subject to a conditional sale contract or a mortgage, from the territory of Guam to any other place outside Guam, unless he is the legal owner thereof, or unless the written authorization of the legal owner thereof has been obtained.

No person owning or having control of any vessel, airplane or other means of transportation, and no agent or employee
of such person, shall transport any such vehicle from the
territory of Guam to any other place outside Guam, or accept the
same for such transportation, or deliver, any bill of lading,
order or other written instrument authorizing such transportation,
unless the person requesting such transportation, (a) produces a
certificate of ownership and a current certificate of registration
showing that he is the legal owner of such vehicle or (b) produces,
if he is not the legal owner thereof, a current certificate of
registration showing that he is the registered owner of such
vehicle and, in addition thereto, the written consent of the legal
owner thereof to such transportation.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment not exceeding six (6) months, or by a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500), or by both."
