

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 2981 TO THE CIVIL CODE
OF GUAM PERTAINING TO THE UNLAWFUL REMOVAL
OF MOTOR VEHICLES SUBJECT TO A CONDITIONAL
SALE CONTRACT OR MORTGAGE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 2981 is hereby added to the Civil Code of Guam
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 2981. Unlawful removal of motor vehicles
5 subject to a conditional sale contract or mortgage. It shall
6 be unlawful for any person to remove, attempt to remove, cause
7 to be removed or assist in so doing any motor vehicle subject
8 to a conditional sale contract or a mortgage, from the territory
9 of Guam to any other place outside Guam, unless he is the legal
10 owner thereof, or unless the written authorization of the legal
11 owner thereof has been obtained.

12 No person owning or having control of any vessel, air-
13 plane or other means of transportation, and no agent or employee
14 of such person, shall transport any such vehicle from the
15 territory of Guam to any other place outside Guam, or accept the
16 same for such transportation, or deliver any bill of lading,
17 order or other written instrument authorizing such transportation,
18 unless the person requesting such transportation, (a) produces a
19 certificate of ownership and a current certificate of registration
20 showing that he is the legal owner of such vehicle or (b) produces,
21 if he is not the legal owner thereof, a current certificate of
22 registration showing that he is the registered owner of such
23 vehicle and, in addition thereto, the written consent of the legal
24 owner thereof to such transportation.

Any person violating any of the provisions of
this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable
by imprisonment not exceeding six (6) months, or by a fine
not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500), or by both."
