AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 23132.2 TO CHAPTER  
2, TITLE XXIV OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM,  
RELATING TO ILLEGAL PARKING.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby enacted a new Section 23132.2 to  
3 Chapter 2, Title XXIV of the Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

4 "Section 23132.2. Registered Owner Responsible,  
5 Illegal Parking. In any prosecution charging a violation  
6 of any regulation governing the standing or parking of a  
7 vehicle under this Title, proof by the government that the  
8 particular vehicle described in the complaint was parked  
9 in violation of any provision of this Title, together  
10 with proof that the defendant named in the complaint  
11 was at the time of parking the registered owner of the  
12 vehicle, shall constitute in evidence a prima facie  
13 presumption that the registered owner of the vehicle  
14 was the person who parked or placed the vehicle at the  
15 point where, and for the time during which, the violation  
16 occurred."

17 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
