

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 25318.1 TO THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM PERTAINING TO FALSE IDENTIFICATION
BY MINORS IN THE PURCHASE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 25318.1 is hereby added to the Government
Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 25318.1. **Minor: False Identification by**
Minor. Any person, under twenty-one years of age, who
exhibits a false identification card or false document
for the purpose of purchasing or obtaining alcoholic
beverages shall be punished by a fine of not more than
five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment not
exceeding six (6) months, or by both such fine and
imprisonment."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
