AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTIONS 1157.26 AND 1157.27 OF THE CIVIL CODE OF GUAM, AND TO ENACT NEW SECTIONS 1157.26 AND 1157.27 TO THE CIVIL CODE OF GUAM PERTAINING TO DUPLICATE CERTIFICATE OF TITLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. Sections 1157.26 and 1157.27 of the Civil Code of
Guam are hereby repealed.

Section 2. A new Section 1157.26 is hereby added to the Civil Code of Guara to read as follows:

"Section 1157.26. Duplicate certificates on loss or destruction of original. In the event of a duplicate certificate of title being lost, mislaid, or destroyed. the sweer may apply to the registrar for a certified copy of the original certificate of registration. If the registrar is satisfied that the applicant is the person named in the original certificate on file in the registrar's office, and that the duplicate certificate has been lost, mislaid, or destroyed, he shall issue a certified copy of the original certificate to the applicant with the memorials and notations appearing upon the register, and shall note upon the certified copy: "Owner's certified copy. issued in place of lost (mislaid or destroyed, as the case may be) certificate, and such certified copy shall stand in the place of, and have like effect as, the missing duplicate certificate.

A certified copy of the certificate of title may be issued by the registrar for use as evidence, upon the receipt by him of an order therefor made by the court: Provided, that such certified copy shall have written or stamped across

the face thereof the words 'for use as evidence only'.

The issuance of such certified copy and the purpose
thereof shall also be noted upon the original certificate
by the registrar."

Section 3. A new Section 1157.27 is hereby added to the Civil Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 1157.27. Mistake: Correction. If an owner's name or description is incorrectly registered, or becomes changed (e.g., by marriage, adoption, divorce, etc.), the registrar shall, if he is satisfied that the applicant is the same person as that appearing in the original certificate, and the production by the applicant of the duplicate certificate, issue a new certificate, with such changes as the case may require."

Section 4. This Act is an argency measure.
