AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 23133 OF TITLE XXIV,  
CHAPTER 2 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, AND  
TO ENACT A NEW SECTION 23133, PERTAINING TO  
UNATTENDED MOTOR VEHICLES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 23133 of Title XXIV, Chapter 2 of the Government  
3 Code of Guam, is hereby repealed and a new Section 23133 is hereby enacted to  
4 read as follows:

5 "Section 23133. Unattended motor vehicles. No  
6 person driving or in charge of a motor vehicle shall  
7 permit it to stand unattended without first stopping the  
8 engine, locking the ignition, removing the ignition key  
9 and effectively setting the brake and, when standing  
10 upon any grade, turning the front wheels to the curb  
11 or side of the highway."

12 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
