AN ACT TO ADD NEW SECTION 6117 TO CHAPTER 2. TITLE VII. GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATING TO CONTRACTS WITH THE UNITED STATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 6117 is hereby added to Chapter 2. Title VII.

Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"Section 6117. Contracts with United States for services. The Governor is authorized to enter agreements with the United States, or any agency or instrumentality thereof, including the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, for the furnishing by the Government of Guam of services, including labor and use of equipment, on a reimbursable basis. All proceeds derived from such agreements shall be paid into the General Fund of the Government of Guam, except that to the extent such services are furnished by the Commercial Port of Guam or the Public Utility Division, reimbursement shall be paid into the Commercial Port of Guam Fund or Public Utility Agency of Guam Fund, respectively."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
