AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27208 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAR PERTAINING TO LICENSING OF PRACTICAL NURSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAR:

Section 1. Section 27208 of the Government Code of Guara is hereby

mended to read as follows:

"Section 27208, Same; practical nurse. Every applicant for a license as a practical nurse must produce evidence of having graduated from an elementary school or its equivalent which shall be satisfactory to the board, must pay an application fee of ten dollars (\$10,00) which shall not be returned, shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age; and either

- (a) Have completed a course of training in a school of practical nursing of not less than twelve (12) months duration which included both classroom and clinical work at a school accredited for vocational or practical nurse training in one of the states or territories of the United States, the accreditation standards of which state or territory are satisfactory to the board, or
- (b) Have successfully completed a course of training in the Guam School of Practical Nursing." Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
