AN ACT TO SUSPEND THE OPERATION OF SECTION 1015 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM AS TO THE SECOND PORTION OF THE ANNUAL REGULAR SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE DURING THE YEAR 1962.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 1015 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby suspended and declared inoperative as to the reconvening of the Legislature following the first thirty consecutive calendar days session that commenced January 8, 1962, and the second portion of the annual regular session of the Guam Legislature during the year 1962 shall be held as follows:

- (a) At the conclusion of the thirty consecutive calendar days session commencing January 8, 1962, the Legislature shall adjourn to the 14th day of May, 1962.
- (b) Reconvening on the 14th day of May, 1962, at the hour of 5:30 p.m., the Legislature shall thereupon remain in session thirty consecutive calendar days.

Section 2. Effective January 1, 1963, the provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall become inoperative, and thereupon the provisions of Section 1015 of the Government Code of Guam shall remain in full force and effect; and that thenseforth all annual regular sessions of the Guam Legislature shall be held in accordance with such section.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
