AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1962, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN:

Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to supplement prior appropriations for the operation of the Executive Branch of the Government of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962:

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$290,000 to complete the Government of Guam's contribution to the Ketirement Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$200,000 for allowable travel and transportation expense of the Executive Branch of the Government of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962.

Section 4. The appropriation made in Section 1. Public Law 6-18 for the Office of the Governor in the amount of \$95,204, is hereby amended to \$76,204, and the sum of \$19,000, being the amount by which said appropriation is thereby reduced, is hereby returned to Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund.

Section 5. The Governor of Guam may transfer not to exceed ten per cent (10%) of any appropriation of Section 1, above, to any other item or items of the appropriation of Section 1, but no item of appropriation shall be increased more than ten percentum as a result of such transfer; provided, that quarterly a statement of any such transfer shall be transmitted to the Guam Legislature. Whenever in order to promote efficiency and economy of operation of the Executive Branch of the government, the Governor provides for the transfer of responsibility for the administration of any function or program from one department to another of the Government of Guam, he may also direct the transfer of funds allocated to such function or program, notwithstanding the amount so transferred is in excess of ten per cent (10%) of the total amount appropriated for either such department.

Section 6. This Act is an urgency seasure.
