AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR
THE OPERATION OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE
GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING
JUNE 30, 1962, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from any
3 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to
4 supplement prior appropriations for the operation of the Executive Branch
5 of the Government of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962:

18 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available
19 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$290,000
20 to complete the Government of Guam's contribution to the Retirement Fund
21 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962.

22 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds
23 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$200,000 for
24 allowable travel and transportation expense of the Executive Branch of
25 the Government of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962.

1 Section 4. The appropriation made in Section 1, Public Law 6-10
2 for the Office of the Governor in the amount of \$95,204, is hereby amended
3 to \$76,204, and the sum of \$19,000, being the amount by which said
4 appropriation is thereby reduced, is hereby returned to Unappropriated
5 Surplus of the General Fund.

6 Section 5. The Governor of Guam may transfer not to exceed ten
7 per cent (10%) of any appropriation of Section 1, above, to any other item
8 or items of the appropriation of section 1, but no item of appropriation
9 shall be increased more than ten percentum as a result of such transfer;
10 provided, that quarterly a statement of any such transfer shall be
11 transmitted to the Guam Legislature. Whenever in order to promote
12 efficiency and economy of operation of the Executive Branch of the
13 government, the Governor provides for the transfer of responsibility for
14 the administration of any function or program from one department to
15 another of the Government of Guam, he may also direct the transfer of
16 funds allocated to such function or program, notwithstanding the amount
17 so transferred is in excess of ten per cent (10%) of the total amount
18 appropriated for either such department.

19 Section 6. This Act is an urgency measure.
