AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 878 AND 879 OF THE PENAL CODE OF GUAN, PERTAINING TO ASSURING THE APPEARANCE OF WITNESSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. Section 878 of the Penal Code of Guam is hereby amended
to read as follows:

"Section 878. Undertaking of witnesses to appear, when how taken. On holding the defendant to answer, the magistrate may take from each of the material witnesses examined before him on the part of the government of Guam a written undertaking, to the effect that he will appear and testify at the court to which the depositions and statements are to be sent, or that he will forfeit a sum to be fixed by the court, but not to exceed \$500.00."

Section 2. Section 879 of the Penal Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 679. Security for the appearance of witnesses, when and how required. When the magistrate, or a judge of the court in which the action is pending, is satisfied, by proof on eath, that there is reason to believe that any such witness will not appear and testify unless security is required, he may order the witnesses to enter into written undertaking, with sureties, in such sum as he may deem proper, but in no case to exceed \$500.00 for his appearance as specified in the preceding section."

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
