AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 21208, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, AND TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 21208.1 THROUGH 21208.5 TO CHAPTER 3, TITLE XXII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATING TO EXPENDITURES FROM THE PUBLIC UTILITY AGENCY OF GUAM FUND, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAL:

Section 1. Subsection (c) of Section 21208, Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(c) All debts, liabilities and obligations, the cost of plant replacement and expansion, and operating expenses of the said Public Utility Agency, including settlement and payment of any claims arising from its operation are hereby authorized to be paid from said Public Utility Agency of Guam Fund by the Treasurer of Guam upon vouchers properly certified to by the Certifying Officer of the Agency."

Section 2. New Sections 21206.1, 21208.2, 21208.3, 21208.4 and 21208.5 are hereby added to Chapter 3, Title XXII, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"Section 21208.1. Fire hydrants. The cost of installing fire hydrants is authorized to be paid from the Public Utility Agency of Guam Fund. The Fund shall be reimbursed for the furnishing of water delivered at fire hydrants from operating appropriations of the government.

Section 21208.2. Street lights. When authorized by the Governor the cost of installation, maintenance, and operation of street lighting facilities may be paid from the Public Utility Agency of Guam Fund. The Fund shall be reimbursed from operating appropriations of the government for the cost of electric power furnished to such facilities.

Section 21208.3. Improvements for Subdivisions.

Where economically feasible, the installation of power, water and telephone lines, and fire hydrants, in subdivisions qualifying under the Subdivision Law, is authorized to be paid from the Public Utility Agency of Guem Fund.

Section 21206.4. Retirement Law. All contributions by the government to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund under Chapter 3. Title V. Government Code of Guam, with respect to employees whose compensation is paid from the Public Utility Agency of Guam Fund, shall be paid from the Public Utility Agency of Guam Fund.

Section 21206.5. Service Charge. Three (3%) per cent of all gross revenue received by the Public Utility Agency of Guam Fund shall be paid by such Fund into the General Fund of the Government of Guam as reimbursement for management and other administrative services, including payments under the workmen's Compensation Law, furnished by other departments and agencies of the Government of Guam."

Section 3. All prior use of the Public Utility Agency of Guam
Fund for the installation of street lighting facilities is bereby ratified.
Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure.
