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
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 14003 TO CHAPTER 1,
TITLE XV, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, AND TO AMEND
SUBSECTION (c) OF SECTION 14002, GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM, CONCERNING THE COMMERCIAL PORT OF
GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 14003 is hereby added to Chapter 1,
Title XV, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"Section 14003. Retirement Law. All contributions by
the government to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund under
Chapter 3, Title V, Government Code of Guam, with respect to
employees whose compensation is paid from the Commercial Port
of Guam Fund, shall be paid from the Commercial Port of Guam
Fund."

Section 2. Subsection (c) of Section 14002, Government Code
of Guam, is hereby amended to read:

"(c) All monies received by the Commercial Port of Guam
from whatever source derived shall be deposited in said
Commercial Port of Guam Fund. All debts, liabilities and
obligations, capital expenditures, and operating expenses of
the said Commercial Port, including the payment of any claims
arising from its operations, shall be paid from said fund.
The Director of Commerce, or such other person as he may
designate, is hereby authorized to settle and pay any and all
cargo and property damage claims arising out of the operations
of the Commercial Port of Guam, up to and including the value
of \$25.00. Where the claim is greater than \$25.00, in value,
the Director of Commerce, or such other officer of the
Government as the Governor may designate, is hereby authorized,

1 subject to the legal review and approval of the Attorney
2 General of Guam, to settle and pay any and all cargo and
3 property damage claims arising out of the operations of the
4 Commercial Port of Guam; provided, however, that such claims
5 must be presented to the Commercial Port of Guam within one
6 year after the accrual thereof in order to be paid as provided
7 herein."

8 Section 3. This Act shall take effect as of July 1, 1962.

9 Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure.
