AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 20004 AND 20004.1 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN PERTAINING TO THE LOW COST HOUSING FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN: Section 1. Section 20004 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

> "Section 20004. Direct Loans. To further assist the development and advancement of agricultural, industrial, commercial, construction, bousing and related pursuits in Guam, the Finance Agency may make direct leans to borrowers in those cases where adequate financing is not available on reasonable terms from a Lending Agency, even with a guarantee from the Guarantee Fund, for a project approved by the Board. Such loans may be made from, but only from, the Finance Agency Guarantee Fund and upon such perms and conditions and under such rules and regulations as the Board may prescribe."

Section 2. Section 20004.1 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

> "Section 20004.1. Seven Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$770,000) of the Guarantee Fund provided by Section 20003 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby reserved and set aside for the following uses and purposes:

(1) Said amount shall be designated as the Special Low Cost Housing Reserve and shall only be used to provide housing loans either for the construction of new structures or the improvement or repair of existing structures is accordance with the provisions of this section.

- (2) No lean in excess of \$8,500 shall be made for the construction of a new structure, and provided further that the value of such structure upon completion shall not exceed \$10,000.
- (3) No loan shall be made in excess of \$2,500 for the improvement or repair of an existing structure, and provided further that the value of such structure after the improvement or repair shall not exceed \$10,000.
- (4) Loans shall be available only for the construction, improvement or repair of single family houses to be occupied by the borrower. Only the head of a family, or husband and wife jointly, shall be eligible to be a borrower. No person shall be eligible for more than one loan.
- (5) Subject to the other conditions of this section, it is particularly intended that this reserve be used to provide direct loans in cases where existing structures or lot sizes do not conform to the minimum standards of the Federal Housing Administration."

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
